

**Advisory for submission of application and Conn-BG3 as per CERC order
11/SM/2023 dated 22-09-2023**

Date: 25-09-2023

CERC has issued an order 11/SM/2023 dated 22-09-2023 on Removal of difficulties (First Order) in giving effect to certain provisions of CERC GNA Regulations 2022. Item no 18 of this order refers to entities which have declared COD as on 1.10.2023, are connected to the grid, and were evacuating their power on a short-term basis. Such entities are required to apply in advance to CTU as per relevant Regulations of transition as under keeping the reasonable processing time that may be taken by CTUIL.

1. **Connectivity quantum effective for which no LTA applied/granted under Connectivity Regulation 2009** - To apply for additional GNA (offline) as per Regulation 17.2 and processing as per 37.6(1).
2. **Quantum of project capacity connected to grid for which no connectivity granted under Connectivity Regulation 2009** - To apply for connectivity on NSW portal(online) as per Regulation 4.1 and processing as per 37.6(1).

However, to avoid any bottling up of such quantum of power, till the time CTUIL processes their request of transition, if they wish to schedule their power, they may deposit Conn-BG3 for Rs 2 lac/MW provisionally. On receipt of such Conn-BG3, CTUIL shall issue provisional permission to such entities which shall be treated as deemed T-GNA, as provided under Regulation 37.6(1) of the GNA Regulations.

Accordingly, all such entities are advised to submit the application and Conn-BG3 @ Rs. 2 lac/MW.
