Advisory for Sharing Dedicated Connectivity Infrastructure by connectivity applicants/grantees under GNA Regulations

For efficient and economical utilization of ISTS system, CTU may grant connectivity to applicant(s), wherever possible, through sharing of bay at ISTS substation and dedicated connectivity system of already granted / agreed for grant of connectivity, if margins are available in the Dedicated Transmission line and allocated bay(s). Both parties i.e. Connectivity grantee(s)/ entity for whom grant of connectivity has already been agreed and applicant/ entity, to whom connectivity is being granted, shall share the dedicated connectivity infrastructure as decided in the CMETS meeting. During the CMETS meeting, the entity responsible for development of dedicated connectivity system & the entity responsible for sharing of above dedicated connectivity system shall be mentioned. CTU will proceed for issuance of intimation/grant (modified intimation if already issued) mentioning the sharing responsibility as agreed in CMETS meeting. Applicant(s) shall comply all the regulatory requirement(s) of the grant.

Pending cases in this regard would be dealt as per above and intimation would be issued accordingly.
