1.	Name of the Applicant entered in the application is the name of the applicant company and not the name of any individual
2.	Applicant Company is registered under Companies Act, 2013 (in case of RE applicant)
3.	The signatory is authorized by its company's Board of Directors specifically with respect to submission of Connectivity/LTA/MTOA applications to CTU
4.	Affidavit is signed by the authorized person submitting the application
5.	Affidavit is notarized & date of Notarization/Attestation has been provided on affidavit
6.	Application is signed by the person authorized in that behalf
7.	The stamp of the applicant company has been placed on Application
8.	Application and Affidavit (in case of RE connectivity) are digitally signed (Class-3) by the same authorized person before uploading the application (and not scanned after affixing digital signature).
9.	The affidavit submitted has not been used earlier with any other application.
10.	In case the PPA/LOA submitted with the application has been utilized in a previous Stage-II Connectivity application, the details of such Application/Stage-II Connectivity grant has been provided.
11.	NOC (from STU in case of LTA with firm beneficiary(ies) & SLDC in case of MTOA) has been attached with application where injection/drawl point is not directly connected with ISTS
12.	Stamp paper for the Application BG had been purchased in the name of the Bank issuing the BG
13.	For Stage-II connectivity Application, LOA/PPA is issued in the name of the Applicant company.
14.	Start date of LTA/MTOA sought should not be earlier than start date of Connectivity sought.
15.	The date of Board Resolution submitted with the application and the one referred in Affidavit are same.
16.	Proof of payment in addition to bank generated UTR No. has been attached with the application.
17.	Exact application fees alongwith GST has been paid
18.	BG format is same as mentioned in CERC Connectivity Regulations / Detailed Procedure and there is no deviation from the prescribed format.
19.	The total fee against any single application can be submitted using maximum no. of 3 transactions, each having unique UTRs.
20.	UTR(s) shall be specific to an application and cannot be used with any other application(s).
